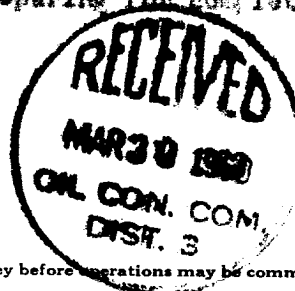

DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 1605'. Ran electric log. 5-1/2" casing was set at 1602' with 50 sacks 6 percent gel cement with 1-1/2 pounds tuf plug per sack, followed by 50 sacks neat cement. Received good circulation throughout. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 3000 psi for 15 minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Released rig on March 25, 1960. Preparing for completion operations.
