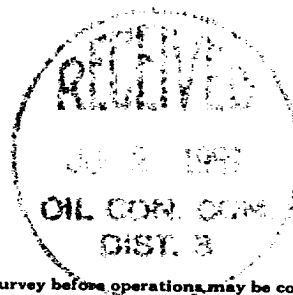

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

On June 25, 1959, 5-1/2" casing was set at 1745 feet and cemented with 80 sacks 66 gal cement mixed with 1-1/2 pounds Taf-Fing per sack followed by 50 sacks neat cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 2000 psi for thirty minutes with no indication of pressure drop. Resumed completion operations.
