We propose to cease continuous operation of this well as presently economical to operate. Well is producing 2 BOPD & 18 BWPD. We do expect to periodically test the well to detect any significant increase in its oil producing capability. If this change occurs, the well will be returned to producing status. We propose to start shut in on January 1, 1968.
