

DETAILS OF WORK

O. J. Hoover "B" Well No. 3. On November 19, 1958, 4-1/2" casing was landed at 1978' with 120 sacks 6% gel cement with 1-1/2 pound Tuf Plug per sacks followed by 50 sacks neat cement. 4-1/2" casing was tested with 2900 pounds pressure for 15 minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
