DETAILS OF WORK

**South Chimney Rock Navajo Well No. 2. Spudded 8-1/4" hole on October 22, 1959, and drilled to 46'. 7" casing was landed at 46' with 22 sacks of cement. Cement circulated. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 150 pounds air pressure for 15 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 6-1/4" at 46' and resumed drilling operations.**
