Re: Application for Exception to Rule 1(a) of Order No. R-128-C for Non-Standard Proration Unit, Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the North Half (N/2) (or NE/4, SE/4 NW/4, NE/4 NW/4, and Lots 1 and 2) of Section 7, Township 30 North, Range 10 West. San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The Sullivan #1 Well, located 1694 feet from the North line and 1090 feet from the East line of Section 7, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, was completed as a gas well on September 2, 1953, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system August 31, 1953.
 - 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 315.90 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
 - 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit liew wholly within a single governmental section.
 - 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
 - 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.

Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of Rule 1 (b) of Order No. R-128-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 1 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.


