Dear Bill:

Enclosed is a Notice of Intention to Drill on W.P. Carr #1 Bird in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8-30N-11W. On June 7, 1954, Mr. R. R. Spurrier, Director of the Commission, approved an unorthodox location in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8-30N-11W. This well was called W.P. Carr #1 Crandall. Subsequent to this time Mr. Carr discovered that there was an error in the survey and that the location should have been 1950' from the North line and 1450' from the West line, Section 8-30N-11W and should have been designated W.P. Carr #1 Bird; therefore Mr. Carr is now asking that the new unorthodox location as set out be approved.

I have been to this location on the ground and believe that his reasons for asking for an unorthodox location at this spot are justified. If you approve the location as now made, please return the Notice of Intention to Drill to me for approval.
