DETAILS OF WORK

O. J. Hoover "B" Well No. 2-X was spudded on November 18, 1958, and on November 22, 1958, 8-5/8" casing was set at 214' with 160 sacks neat cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 400 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.

Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 214' and resumed drilling operations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
