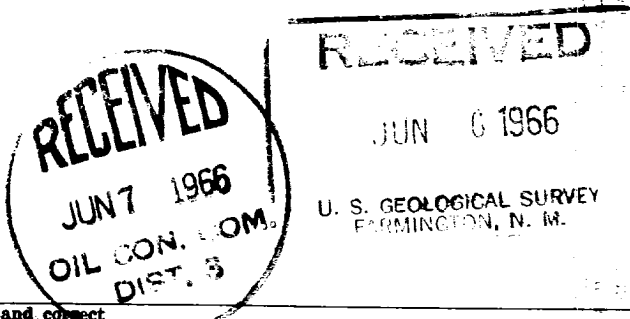

In reference to our Form 9-331 of April 13, 1966, a pulling unit was moved in on the subject Northwest Hogback Unit No. 27 on May 13, 1966 and rods and tubing were pulled from the well. Tubing was run with packer and upper and lower casing perforations were tested selectively. Due to indicated communication between casing perforations, the well was not recomplected, and the well was returned to production on May 19, 1966.
