Gentlemen:

We are enclosing for your approval Corrected Gas Well Plat covering our Thomas and Hampton 1-X wells. This should result in an acreage factor of 79% for the Thomas well in place of the 73% carried on the proration schedule, and an acreage factor of 77% in place of the 75% carried on the schedule for the Hampton 1-X.

We further note that the proration schedule shows an acreage factor of 92% for our Brown #1, 97% for our Hartman #1, and 99% for our Jensen #1. We have filed a Corrected Gas Well Plat for each of the above wells dated April 19, 1955, which shows 160 acres dedicated to each of these wells. They should each have an acreage factor of 100% on the schedule.

Hampton I, and 93% for our Jensen #1. We have filed a
corrected gas well plat for each of the above wells dated
July 10, 1935, which shows 100 acres dedicated to each
of these wells. They should each have an average factor
of 100% on the schedule.
