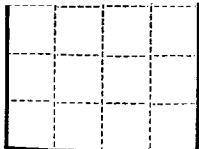

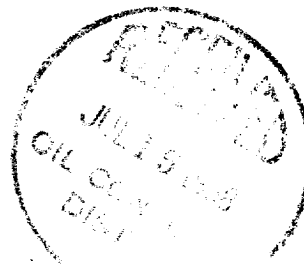

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded June 28, 1958. Set 3 5/8" casing at 95' with 100 sacks cement. Tested for 30 minutes with 300 lbs. pressure, no leaks. Drilled cement plug June 30, 1958. Tested for 30 minutes with 300 lbs. pressure, no drop in pressure.
