- 1/23/97 A-Plus Well Service mixed and pumped 66 sacks Class B cement, plug from 1362' to 800' to cover Gallup top and perforations. Tag cement top at 1335'. Mixed and pumped 66 sacks Class B cement, plug from 1323' to 755'. Tagged cement at 1002'.
- 1/28/97 Perforated squeeze holes at 137'. Mixed and pumped 54 sacks Class B neat cement. Circulated cement from annulus and left casing full. Cut off wellhead and installed regulation dry hole marker with 25 sacks of cement.

Casing remaining in hole:

Surface casing: 8-5/8", 24#, J-55 casing to 87'

Production casing: 5-1/2", 14#, J-55 to 1412'
