Dear Mr. Spurrier:

We have recently filed our application to drill our Hartman #1 well to be located 846 feet from the North line and 2024 feet from the East line of Section 8, Township 30 West, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool.

We were unable to obtain in our oil and gas leases covering two of the orthodox locations in this quarter section the right for any surface drilling. We have tried again to obtain this permission, but the land owner will not grant it due to the high state of cultivation in which he has in this land. The location we have applied for is the nearest to an orthodox location which we could make under the terms of our leases in the area.
