DETAILS OF WORK

As a result of no commercial prospects for the temporarily abandoned South Chimney Rock Navajo No. 1, we propose to permanently plug and abandon the well as follows:

- (1) Pump 15 sacks of cement down the 4-1/2" casing and squeeze with minimum pressure to leave casing perforations covered with 50 to 75 feet of cement.
- (2) Fill hole with fluid and spot 5 sacks of cement for surface plug.
- (3) Erect abandonment marker and clean up location.

Verbal approval for above procedure received December 2, 1960, from Mr. Baker to Mr. Bauer.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

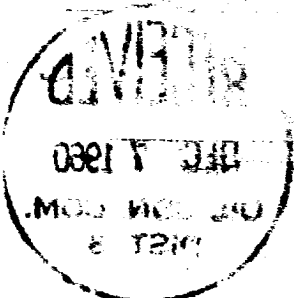
