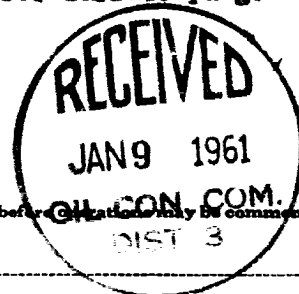

DETAILS OF WORK

As a result of not obtaining oil or gas in commercial quantities, South Chimney Rock Navajo Well No. 1 was plugged and abandoned as follows on January 1, 1961:

Total depth 770', plug back depth 732'

1. Pumped 15 sacks cement plug down 4-1/2" casing and squeezed with 200 psi. Top of cement at 470'.
2. Filled hole with fluid and spotted 5 sacks of cement for surface plug.
3. Erected abandonment marker and cleaned up location.
