USA Joseph W. Aidlin Well No. 1. On July 9, 1950, 5-1/2" casing was set at 1665' with 100 sacks of 60 gal cement followed by 50 sacks neat cement. Pressured up on casing to 2500 pounds, bled off to 1000 pounds in 7 minutes. Ran temperature survey, top cement at 430'. Displaced oil with water. Set HSS tool at 1616. Pressured below to 2500 pounds, bled off to 1000 pounds in 2 minutes. Pumped in 1/4 barrels per minute at 2500 pounds. Ran tubing with 4-3/4" bit. Drilled out float collar, circulated to 1662'. Encountered no cement. Ran cast iron bridge plug set at 1646'. Ran dump bailer and cased with one sack cement. Tested casing to 2500 pounds pressure for 15 minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
