

DETAILS OF WORK

The well was placed on production and produced 300 barrels load oil. A radioactive tracer survey showed that fluid was entering the formation in interval 202'-2118'. 19,000 gal. of oil was pumped into the formation at a rate of 3 BPM and max. pressure 150 psi. The interval 202'-2054' was perforated with 4 jet shots per foot. The well was placed on production and is presently recovering load oil.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
