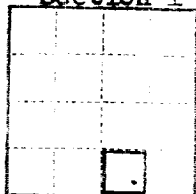

DETAILS OF WORK

Notice of intention to abandon subject well is hereby given. Procedure as follows:

1. Pump 75 sxc. cnt. down 5' csg. following with plug and displace to $\pm$ 1500'. If unable to pump in formation, run generator bkg. to approx. 2100' and spot 75 sxc. cnt. plug.
2. Shoot off csg. at free point ($\pm$ 1500') and recover.
3. Spot cnt. plug 50' in and out of 5 7/8" csg.
4. Spot cnt. plug 50' in and out of 8-5/8" csg.
5. Spot 50' surface plug in 8-5/8" csg. and install 4' x 4" steel marker.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing from the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
