DETAILS OF WORK

Notice of intention to abandon subject well is hereby given. Procedure as follows:

1. Pump 75 sec. out. down 3^{1/2}" csg. following out with plug and displace to $\pm 1500^{\circ}$. If unable to pump in formation, run open-ended csg. to approx. 2100' and spot 75 sec. cmt. plug.
2. Spot off csg. at free point ($\pm 1300'$) and recover.
3. Spot out. plug 50' in and out of 5^{1/2}" csg.
4. Spot out. plug 50' in and out of 5-5/8" csg.
5. Spot 50' surface plug in 3-5/8" csg. and install 4" to 4" steel marker.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
