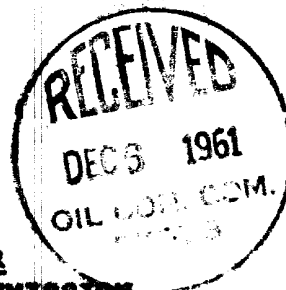


THE APPLICATION OF CONSOLIDATED OIL & GAS, INC. FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS CLAYTON WELL NO. 1-2 LOCATED IN THE SE/4 SW/4 OF SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED GALLUP POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (II) Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 10, 1961, for permission to dually complete its Clayton Well No. 1-2 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 2, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Gallup Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 30th day of November, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection (II) of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

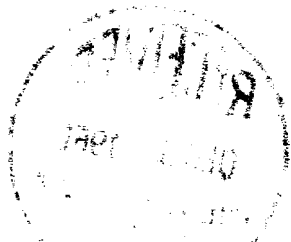
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Clayton Well No. 1-2 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 2, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Gallup Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section VI, Rule 112-A.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (II) Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 10, 1961, for permission to dual complete the Clayton Well No. 1-2 located in the SW/4 of Section 2, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an understated Gallup Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Manota Pool.

Now, on this 10th day of November, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection (II) of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset wells have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dual complete the Clayton Well No. 1-2 located in the SW/4 of Section 2, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an understated Gallup Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Manota Pool through parallel running of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER: That applicant shall comply with the provisions of Section 112-A of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Rules and Regulations.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
