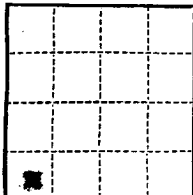

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5504' ft.

**DETAILS OF WORK**

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Drilled to T.D. 1734'. Run csg and cement 1734' of 5 1/2", 15.85 csg with 85 cu. Plugged down at 11:45 p.m., 2-11-59. WOC 24 hrs. Drilled out cement to 1705' with cable tools. Ran Gamma Ray Neutron logs. Perf. csg from 1512' to 1530' and 1644' to 1680' with four shots per foot, then sand-oil frac. perforations in Gallup formation with 30,000 gal. crude plus 50,000 sand.

Started swabbing fluid through csg and lost swab in hole. Probably due to collapse of csg at around 1300'. Plan to set 80' cement plug at around 1250' to 1300' and 10' cement plug at top of pipe.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations can be commenced.
