In accordance with the provisions of Rule No. 112-A, Multiple Completions, as amended by Order No. R-2489, dated May 28, 1963, Pan American Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests Administrative approval to dually complete the L. C. Kelly No. 5, located in Unit I, Section 3, T-30-N, R-12-W, San Juan County, New Mexico, in the Gallup (gas) and Dakota (gas) zones. The L. C. Kelly No. 5 is located approximately one-half mile west of Consolidated Oil and Gas, Inc.'s Clayton No. 1-2, which was approved for dual completion in the same zones by Order No. MC-1121, dated November 30, 1961.

As specified in Rule No. 112-A, we are submitting in quadruplicate an Application for Dual Completion, a Diagramatic Sketch of Dual Completion, a plat showing the location of the L. C. Kelly No. 5 with respect to offsetting wells, including the names and addresses of offset operators. 
