Implementation of a CO2 flood would require the workover of existing wells, and the drilling of new wells. For these reasons, ARCO proposes that this well be maintained in the long term shut-in status so that the wellbore will be available, should future production tests indicate commercial production or should it be needed as part of a future CO2 flood. This plan eliminates the economic waste of potentially usable wellbores and promotes conservation.
