The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is **5430** ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

This well was spudded on March 6, 1963.

A 9" hole was drilled with water-base mud to 775' below the rotary table and 770' (measured from ground level) of 7" - J55-20 lb. casing was run and cemented with 175 sacks of cement on March 12, 1963. Cement was circulated to the surface. Plug reached bottom at 12:50 P.M., 3-12-63.

After waiting 30 hours for cement to harden, a pressure of 500 p.s.i. was applied and held for 15 minutes. There was no pressure drop and no apparent leaks.

The water was bailed from the casing and drilling was started with air on March 13, 1963.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
