On June 29, 1961 we received Notice of Intention to Drill for a well located 1430 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the Neet line of Section 3-30N-17N. This well was designated as the #1 Navajo. Our files also reflect that on June 28, 1961 your company plugged a well in the same 40 acres also designated as the #1 Navajo. We also noted that on November 4, 1957 your company plugged a well located in the SNG Section 1-30N-17N designated as the #1 Navajo. We also note that you have a plugged and abandoned well in the NRG Section 35-31N-17N designated as the #2 Navajo, which was completed November 23, 1957.

To prevent confusion in well identification we are, therefore, pending your approval, changing the well numbers on the above named wells as follows:

1980/3; 1980/W, Section 1-30N-17W----#1 Navajo NE Section 35-31N-17W----#2 Navajo 1980/N; 660/W Section 3-30N-17W----#3 Navajo 1430/N; 660/W, Section 3-30N-17W----#4 Navajo.

We would also appreciate it very much if you would designate the next Navajs well spudded as the #5 Navajo. Please indicate if you approve of the above numbering system and if so all information filed on the latest well should be filed as the #4 Navajo well.
