We wish to call your attention to the C-101 and C-128, which were filed on the Blanco State Unit "I" No. 1, which is located in the SW/4NE/4 on State Lease E-7123-1.

The C-101 did not set forth the lease number nor the fact that it was a state lease, the C-128 does not show that the 320 acres is composed of State, Federal and Fee acreage.

Tennessee Gas filed a communitization with this office on June 9, 1958, which we are returning to them for revision and we have pointed out to them the lack of information, and have suggested they should make the proper corrections on these forms.

I am enclosing a copy of the C-128 with the lease numbers inserted for your information.
