Re: Plugging contracts

Dear Perry:

Please let contracts to plug the following two wells:

(1) Unknown operator and well E-16-30N-11W

An attempt was made to locate this well last summer and partial payment to the pluggers inadvertantly released them from the responsibilities. Contract will require:

- (a) Remove fill dirt from an area approximately 200' by 200' to locate well bore.
- (b) Clean out well to TD approximately 900'.
- (c) Cement to 50' above Farmington formation.
- (d) Perforate casing 50' below Ojo Alamo and cement inside and outside of pipe for 100' from perfs.
- (e) Set surface plug and marker.


(2) EPROC Associates Monsanto State H #1 E-2-30N-16W
Order #R-6370
Plugging procedure

- (a) Pressure up on well and establish pumping rate into perfs.
- (b) Pump down wiper plug and tag W/wire line.
- (c) If plug is below top perforation pump twenty sacks of cement followed by wiper plug and wire line.
- (d) Displace plug to 1390' WOC.
- (e) Perforate casing @350'
- (f) Circulate cement from 350' to surface inside and outside of pipe.
- (g) Set marker and clean location.
