Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Products Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of the SW/4 NW/4 (lot 5 and that portion of the SW/4 NW/4 lying west of the Navajo Indian Reservation boundary line) of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Horseshoe Canyon #3-B Well, located 1650' from the North line and 4290' from the East line of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, was completed as an oil well from the Gallup formation on November 19, 1958.
2. That the proposed non-standard oil proration unit consists of 34.59 acres which are contiguous and substantially in the form of a square as shown on the attached plat.
3. That the proposed non-standard oil proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental quarter-quarter section.
4. That the proposed non-standard oil proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of oil.
5. That El Paso Natural Gas Products Company is the owner of all the interest in the fractional SW/4 NW/4, Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, and that all operators owning interests in acreage offsetting the non-standard proration unit are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard oil proration unit.

El Paso Natural Gas Products Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard production unit consisting of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 (lot 5 and that portion of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 lying west of the Navajo Indian Reservation boundary line) of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Horseshoe Canyon #3-B Well, located 1620' from the North line and 4290' from the East line of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, was completed as an oil well from the Gallup formation on November 19, 1928.
2. That the proposed non-standard oil production unit consists of 34.29 acres which are contiguous and substantially in the form of a square as shown on the attached plat.
3. That the proposed non-standard oil production unit lies wholly within a single governmental quarter-quarter section.
4. That the proposed non-standard oil production unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of oil.
5. That El Paso Natural Gas Products Company is the owner of all the interest in the fractional SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, and that all operators owning interests in acreage offsetting the non-standard production unit are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard oil production unit.


