The 4-1/2" casing will be cemented by two stage method with stage tool set about 100' below base of Pictured Cliffs. First stage will consist of sufficient cement to fill minimum 900' above top Gallup. Second stage will consist of sufficient cement to circulate to surface. Stimulation and completion will be as indicated upon reaching total depth. Copies of location plat are attached. Copies of any logs taken will be submitted upon completion of well.


