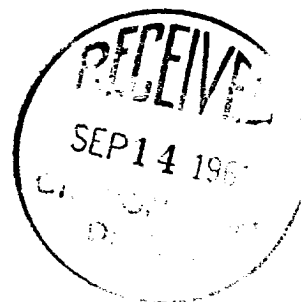

The subject well in the Basin Dakota Field in San Juan County, was re-tested on 4-6-61 for the current year deliverability and form C-122 A was filed on 4-25-61. The computed deliverability was 488 MCF on the new test and had been 325 MCF on the test taken in October, 1960.

The September San Juan Gas Proration Schedule still carries the 325 figure. Is there some forms that we might have over looked or misfiled that are required on the retest? If there is anything that we might do to have the new deliverability assigned to this well, please let me know.

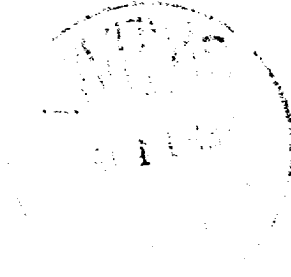
