Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Navajo C No. 1-X Well to be located 1530 feet from the North line and 610 feet from the West line and in the NW/4 of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 17 West, undesignated Dakota Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW/4 NW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you own all offset acreage, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) (2) of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
