DETAILS OF WORK

Perforated the interval 1736-46; scrubbed and out oil. Treated with 300 gallons of acid. Bailed 20 gallons of fluid in one hour, with a slight show of oil. Perforated the interval 1800-47; Fractured with 40,000 gallons of oil, 40,000 lbs. of 1 1/2 rubber balls. The lead was scrubbed and then the well produced 41 barrels of oil per hour for 4 hours. Now scrubbing and out oil.

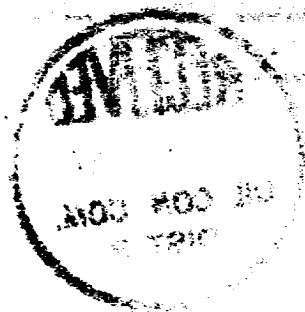
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
