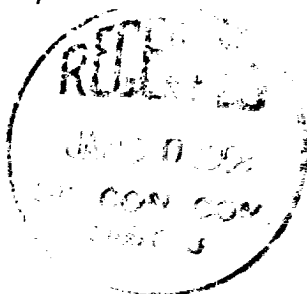
I would appreciate your making this correction to my letter and apologize for any inconveniences this error may have caused your office.
