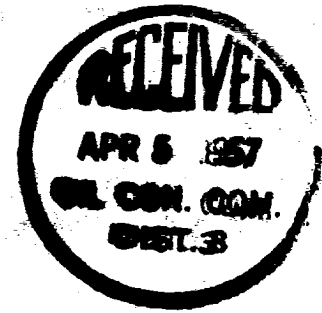

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 54-33 to be located 2500 feet from the North line and 1250 feet from the East line and in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 33, Township 21 North, Range 7 West, Blanco Mesaverte Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the only affected oil operator, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Section 1 (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco Mesaverte Pool, as set forth in Order R-118 as amended by Order R-397, you are hereby granted an exception to Section 1 (c) of Order R-118 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
