Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Well No. 58-34 to be located 1100 feet from the North line and 265 feet from the East line and in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 34, Township 31 North, Range 7 West, Blanco Mesaverde Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the operator of the Northeast Blanco Unit and all leases within a 790 foot radius of the proposed unorthodox location are jointly controlled by the Northeast Blanco participants, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, as set forth in Order R-110, as amended by Order No. R-397, you are hereby granted an exception to Section 1 (c) and Paragraph 4 of Orders R-110 and R-397 respectively for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
