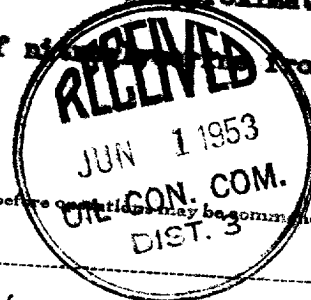
DETAILS OF WORK

 The objective sands are the Cliff House and Point Lookout, expected at about 4900' and 5300' respectively.

Approximate casing program: 175' of 10-3/4" O.D. casing cemented to top,
4900' of 7" O.D. cemented with 200' sacks.

Well will be drilled with rotary tools to top of Cliff House and pay sands will be drilled with rotary using natural gas method to a total depth of approximately 5600'.

Well will then be shot with approximately 1800 quarts of nitro from 4950' to total depth.

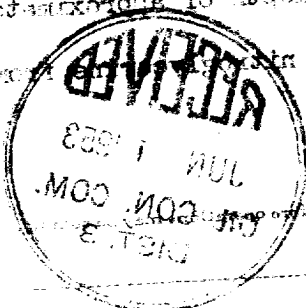

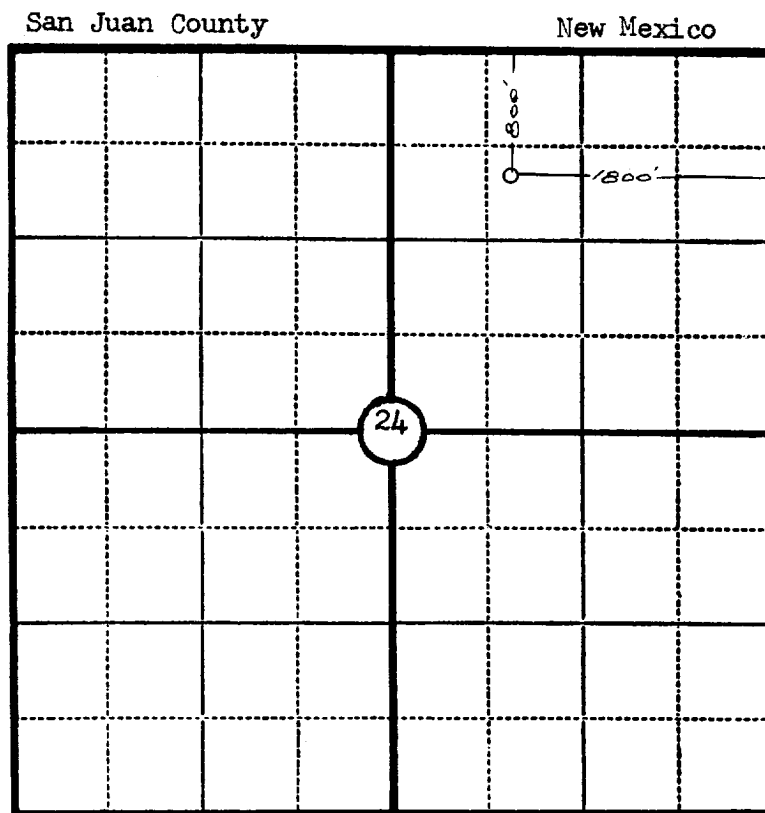
