**On November 19, 1952, set 292' of 10-3/4" OD 32.75# E-40 casing at 301' and circulated cement with 175 sacks of Ideal Cement.**

**Tested casing with 700# for 30 minutes prior to drilling plug and tested formation with 700# for 30 minutes after drilling plug. No loss of pressure on either test.**

**The elevation of the derrick floor is 6427 feet above sea level.**
