FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WE PROPOSE TO:

1. Pull tubing. Run casing inspection tool in 5-1/2" OD, Casing to locate hole in casing.
2. Squeeze casing leak with necessary amount of cement to shut off casing leak.
3. Clean out to T.D. of 6901 ft. Run approx. 900 ft. 4", OD., 10.44# flush joint casing as a liner. (Top 5001', Bottom 5901')
4. Pressure test casing and liner to 2000# PSI.
5. Perforate and frac Point Lookout and Cliff House in and effort to stimulate production.
6. Re-run tubing and place well back on production.
