The objective sands are the Cliff House and Point Lookout, expected at about 5025' and 5400' respectively.

Approximate casing program: 175' of 10-3/4" O.D. casing cemented to surface
 5025' of 7" O.D. cemented with 350 sacks

Well will be drilled with rotary tools to top of Cliff House and casing set. Pay sands will be drilled with rotary tools using natural gas drilling in method. Total depth will be about 5700'.

Well will then be shot with approximately 1000 quarts of nitro glycerine from 5075' to total depth.

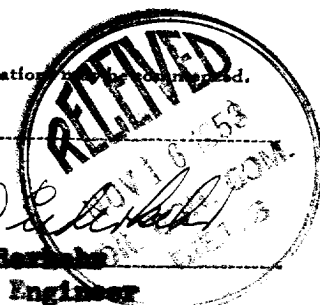
