Gentlemen:

This is a request by Anderson-Prichard Oil Corporation for an exception to State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Order No. R-128-D, Rule No. 1, Paragraph A, under conditions set out in Rule No. 1, Paragraph B, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. That this non-standard gas production unit consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections or lots, it being the West half of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico;
2. That this non-standard gas production unit lies wholly in Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico;
3. That this non-standard gas production unit is believed to be productive of gas; and
4. That written consent in the form of waivers from all operators owning an interest in which this gas production unit lies, and all offset operators to the same unit, permitting us to produce gas from this non-standard production unit will be acknowledged and forwarded to your District Office in Artec, New Mexico.

We wish to apologize for being late in filing this application with the Commission, as we were unaware of the fact that this procedure would



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necessary until we were informed by your District Manager in Aztec, New Mexico, Mr. Emery Arnold. Our Notice of Intention to Drill with surveyor's plat was filed with and approved by the U. S. Geological Survey in Farmington, New Mexico, and a copy of the above instrument was sent to the Commission office at Aztec, New Mexico.

Enclosed is a copy of the Waiver sent to offset operators for acknowledgment, with plat of acreage dedicated to this non-standard production unit. We trust this application meets with your approval, and if anything additional is needed we will give it our prompt attention.

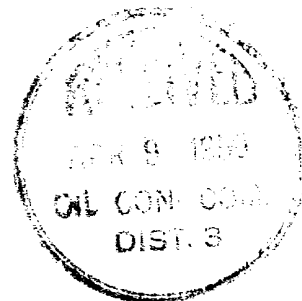
