

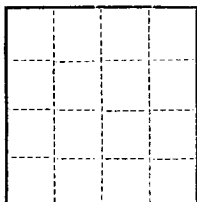

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools through the Mesaverde formation, drilling the top section with gas circulation, and to shoot the entire Mesaverde with approximately 2 quarts of S.N.G. per foot. Estimated total depth 5800.

Casing Program:

1 5/8 25.4# P.S. set at 170', cemented with 125 sacks, circulated 7" 20# & 23#, set at 5300', cemented with 500 sacks with 35 gel and 1 lb. floccule.

The 21 1/2" section is dedicated to this well
