1. Ran 6 jts. 10-3/4", 32.75#, H-40 surface csg. on July 17, 1959, landed at 207' R.K.B. Cemented w/175 sx. reg. cement w/2% calcium chloride.
2. Drilled plug and pressured up to 500 psi for 30 mins. on July 18, 1959 - Pressure held.
3. Ran 93 jts. 7-5/8", 26.40#, J-55 casing on July 28, 1959, landed at 3699' R.K.B. Cemented w/200 sx reg. cement w/2% gel.
4. Drilled plug & pressured up to 500 psi for 30 mins. on July 29, 1959 - Pressure held.
