Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Well No. 60-27 to be located 500 feet from the South line and 1970 feet from the West line and in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 31 North, Range 7 West, Blanco Mescavado Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the operator of the Northeast Blanco unit and all leases within a 750 foot radius of the proposed unorthodox location are jointly controlled by the Northeast Blanco participants, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted to under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco Mescavado Pool, as set forth in Order R-110, as amended by Order No. R-397, you are hereby granted an exception to Section I (c) and Paragraph A of Orders R-110 and R-397 respectively for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
