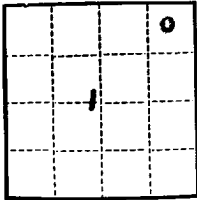

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Well spudded on August 11, 1959.
2. Ran 6 jts 10-3/4", 32.75#, H-40 surface casing on August 11, 1959. Casing landed at 221' R.K.B. Cemented with 125 sacks regular cement with 2% calcium chloride.
3. Drilled plug and pressured up to 500 psi for 30 minutes on August 12, 1959. Pressure held.
