

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 5540'. Interval treated 5437-5540'.

Set Baker retainer at 5439' and treated Cliff House formation with 3,000 gallons No. 2 diesel oil and 500# sand. Breakdown pressure 400#, maximum pressure 1000#. Injection rate 356 gallons per minute. Flushed with 1,200 gallons oil. Natural gauge 340 MCF. Gauge five hours after treatment 700 MCF. The retainer shipped and it is intended to treat the Cliff House again as soon as the hole is cleaned out.
