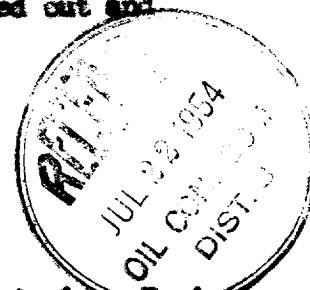

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth 5945', Interval treated 5790' - 5945'.

Set Baker cement retainer at 5790' and treated Point Lockout formation with 10,000 gallons #2 diesel oil and 7,300# sand. Breakdown pressure 700#, maximum pressure 1100#. Injection rate 9.4 barrels per minute. Flushed with 1890 gallons oil. Gage before treatment 82 MCF. (P.L. only) Gage 25 hours after treatment 1,190 MCF. The packer failed, as in two previous attempts and the hole was cleaned out and tubing was run.
