It has come to our attention that through some inadvertence the allowables assigned to this well for the year 1959 were based on a deliverability of 625 MCF/D, rather than a deliverability of 1,625 MCF/D. It is requested that a supplement be issued as soon as possible correcting the allowables on this well retroactive to February 1, 1959 and assigning allowables on the basis of a State deliverability test of 1,625 MCF/D.

Because the assignment of this additional allowable will result in making this well excessively underproduced, we also request an extension of time to January 31, 1961 in which to make up this underproduction. For your information, the well is currently in balance on the basis of production against an allowable based on 625 MCF/D, and would not suffer any cancellation of underproduction on February 1, 1960 except for the assignment of additional allowables retroactive to February 1, 1959. The well is capable of making up the additional underproduction as a result of this additional allowable if given a reasonable time in which to do so.

If it is felt that the relief sought as to the extension of time in which to make up the underproduction cannot be granted administratively, please advise me so that we may make formal application for hearing in this matter.
