It is proposed to drill the well with rotary tools to a depth sufficient to test the Dakota-Bruners formation, estimated top at 6200', estimated total depth 6500'. Surface casing will be 8-5/8" set at approx. 350' and cemented from bottom to top. If productive zones are encountered, 4-1/2" casing will be set and cemented with sufficient cement to protect all zones. Productive zones will be perforated, treated if necessary, and well completed.

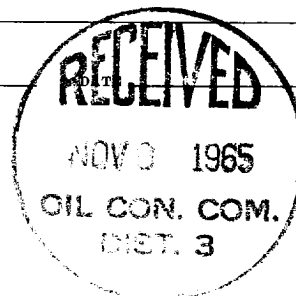

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 1:** If the proposal is to redrill to the same reservoir at a different subsurface location or to a new reservoir, use this form with appropriate notations. Consult applicable State or Federal regulations concerning subsequent work proposals or reports on the well.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

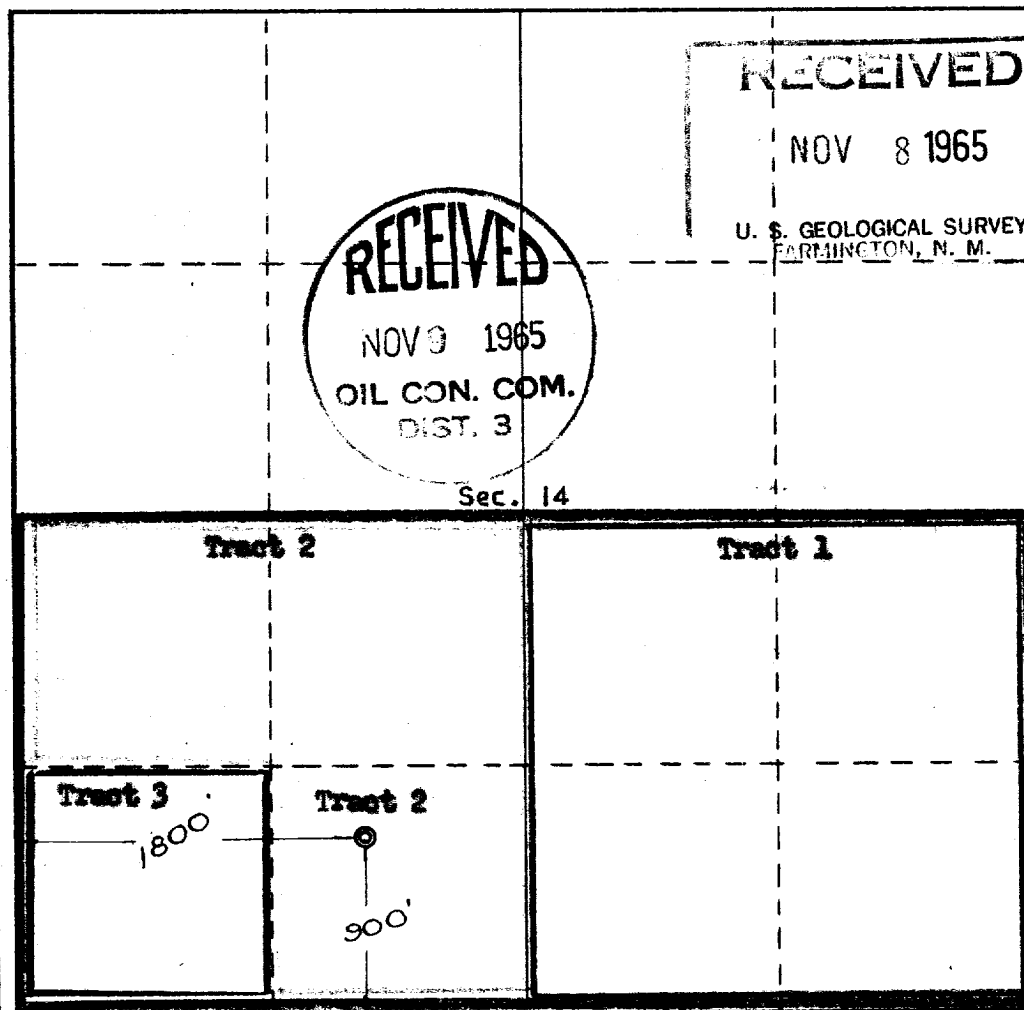
