Administrative Order TX-25

Reference is made to your letter of September 3, 1965, wherein you request authority to complete several wells in Sections 20 and 22, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, with 3-1/2 inch O.D. 7.70# NUE J-55 production casing and to produce the Pictured Cliffs hydrocarbons through said casing string as a tubingless completion.

Inasmuch as you expect that the Pictured Cliffs formation will produce with a high gas liquid ratio, there should be no production problem or waste encountered by your proposed completion, provided that the cement on the aforesaid 3-1/2 inch casing string is circulated to the surface.

Tenneco Oil Company is therefore hereby authorized to complete and produce the following wells in accordance with the aforesaid procedure:
