Amoco Production Company intends to temporarily abandon the Pictured Cliffs formation in the subject well and recomple to the Fruitland Coal formation per the attached procedures.

Amoco also requests approval to construct a temporary 15'x15'x5' (maximum size) blow pit for return fluids. This pit will be reclaimed upon completion of this operation.

Amoco plans to use the well as a monitor well for the Fruitland Coal formation. When production from the Fruitland Coal is terminated, the formation will be plugged. Amoco has gone to hearing to gain approval for a second well in the 320 acre spacing unit with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

Fruitland Recompletion

1. Check location for anchors. Install if necessary. Test anchors.
2. MIRUSU. Blow well down. Kill with 2% KCl if necessary. NDWH. NUBOP.
3. TOOH with 1 1/4" tbg and Model HRC Ret. Cmter. (set at 3030').
4. TIH with bit and scraper. POOH. TIH with Baker CI Invertable pkr and RBP. Set BP at 3070'. Pull 1 std and pressure test BP to 2000#.
5. Spot 2 sxs of sand on top of BP. Set pkr at 2800'. TOH.
6. TIH with 4" perforating gun, 90 deg phasing, minimum 22 gram charge. Perforate underbalanced w/8 JSPF at intervals below:

2822' - 2834'	(12')
2840' - 2853'	(13')
2865' - 2873'	(8')
2940' - 2963'	(23')
2974' - 2984'	(10')
2993' - 2995'	(2')
3006' - 3022'	(16')

Depths correlate to Density Log dated 03-05-66.

7. TIH with PIT pkr. Isolate each set of perforations and break down with 7 1/2% HCl. TOH.
8. TIH with 1 1/4" tubing and land at 3010'.
9. NDBOP. NUWH. RDMOSU.
